BILLY

You know why.

Back to present day.

BILLY
I don't know why! I'm just trying to
get to class on time.

The bus arrives.

PAUL

Here's the bus now. Maybe he's not driving today. They walk to the bus. Richardson opens the door.

BUS DRIVER RICHARDSON

BILLY

BILLY

SHERI

BILLY
(spits in her face)
Fine! I'll ask someone else.
(knocks over a chair then exits)
Back to present day. Billy stands in the bus door flabbergasted.

EXT. BUS STOP - DAY

BILLY
That is not what happened!

Flashback.

INT. THE ROT - DAY

Sheri's at a table studying. Wearing a sweater vest, Billy stumbles over an employee. He looks around and notices that Sheri just broke her pencil. He approaches her.

BILLY
(nervously pulls out a spare
pencil)
Want to use my pencil.

SHERI
No I do not! I'm a lady.

BILLY
(confused)
Fine?...I guess I-I'll--.

He sneezes on her by accident. They look at each other
awkwardly.

Sorry, I'll go ask someone for a napkin---

He slips and knocks over a chair. Feeling very embarrassed,
he runs off.

EXT. BUS STOP - DAY

Present day.

BUS DRIVER RICHARDSON
And you expect me to believe that?

BILLY
Uh, yeah. She's crazy!

BUS DRIVER RICHARDSON
Don't talk about my daughter that way.

BILLY
Sheri's your daughter?!?

BUS DRIVER RICHARDSON
Every girl on this campus is my
daughter.

BILLY
But have a final tomorrow.

SHERI
Later loser.

The bus drives off.

BILLY
Billy two can play at this game.

The next day, Billy in a ridiculous disguise walks on the bus. Believing it worked he gets off the bus at the first stop. He realizes he's in the middle of nowhere.

BILLY
What the?

BUS DRIVER RICHARDSON
Thought you could pull a fast one on
me?

Richardson drives off. Billy tries running him down. He pulls out a lasso and roller skates then tries to rope the back of the bus. It doesn't work. Billy instead trips and lands in a pond.

INT. CLASS ROOM - DAY

Billy sitting at a desk, while everyone else is exiting.

PAUL
I'm glad the prof is letting you
retake the test today.

BILLY
Me too. She can't attend so they're
sending a sub.

PAUL
Who?

BILLY
Does it look like I know?

Just then, Bus Driver Richardson enters.

BILLY
What are you doing here?

BUS DRIVER RICHARDSON
I'm the substitute.

BILLY
